Serving Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Talbot and Queen Anne's counties, Crossroads Community's Board of Directors makes an effort to reflect the demographics of the counties we serve, and include people who are receiving - or have received - mental health services, who are family members of persons who have received mental health services, or are a member of a mental health advocacy group. All Board members are elected for a three-year term and may serve two consecutive terms.



Board members expected to make annual donations to reach 100% full Board giving, defined as significant based on circumstances.



Board meetings take place in Centreville on the 4th Tuesday of every other month, January - November, from 5:30 to 7:30 PM. Attendance may be in-person or virtual.

Over the Course of the Fiscal Year, July 1 - June 30, the Board Reviews and Acts on:

- FY Budget, Quarterly Financial Reports, Annual Audit
- Board and Agency Outcomes related to the Strategic Plan
- Board Performance Evaluation
- Executive Director Performance Evaluation.
- Crossroads' operations
- Periodic reviews related to The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) Accreditation
- A joint meeting with the Board of Corsica River Mental Health Services, subsidiary of Crossroads, occurs in January & September



The three Officer Positions of President, Secretary, and Treasurer comprise the Executive-Finance Committee. Officers are elected annually and may serve consecutive terms in an Officer position. Two additional Directors can be appointed to the committee.



Other committees are Board Governance and Development, Public Relations and Fundraising, and Program Services. All Board members are asked to serve on a committee. Committees can include non-Board members.
